GETTING THERE

Airswift offers daily flights from Manila and Cebu to El Nido, Palawan. Travel time is approximately 1 hour & 15 minutes and 1 hour & 40 minutes, respectively, using a 48-seater ATR aircraft. From Lio Airport in El Nido, guests will take an hour and 30 minutes van ride to Taytay Town Port. A 50-minute boat transfer to Apulit Island from Taytay Town Port follows.
